Project Update.

PARISH SURVEY:

The Trustee is seeking your views on the proposed design that now forms the baseline solution for the new Pavilion and scheme of improvements.

The Charity has decided that in addition to the input from the newly established Management Team, there is a need to seek the views of the general public as to whether or not the proposed solution still meets with their requirements

In order to obtain these views the Trustee has established an online survey that can be accessed via our website <http://www.willitonparishcouncil.org/memorial-ground/pavilion-project>. Here you can view project drawings and provide your views and opinions on the proposed solution. The website will only allow one entry per household, however paper versions of the survey will be located within the Parish Office, Post Office, SPAR, Library, Doctors Surgery and Children's Centre .

Collection and drop off points will be the Parish Office, Post Office and SPAR.

The Survey is being conducted in conjunction with the Community Council for Somerset and shall be open for entries between 2nd November and 27th November.

Fund Raising:

We are pleased to announce that we have been successful with our bid for £70,000.00 from the EDF Liesure Fund. This now takes our total to £574,000.00.

During October we submitted our Stage 2 application to the Big Lottery and also registered our interest in bidding for Sport England funding, if successful with our register of interest, we will be busy during the coming months working with ENGAGE on an application for funding that will also include the proposed MUGA .

The next project update will not be until January when we hope to have the summary results from the November survey.
