Project Update.

Pavilion:

We still await the decision by the Big Lottery though indications are promising. They have contacted us and arranged a meeting with their representative on Thursday 30th June to discuss the project. They continue to show a keen interest and hopefully we shall soon have some good news. At the Village Fete we plan to have the drawings on display and we will be seeking your views on the revised floor plan and the additional functionality the amended design now offers.

Project funding, available and pledged funding now exceeds £600,000.00 and the figure continues to grow through the charity fund raising efforts. Your continued support through attendance at events and coffee mornings last year raised over £9,000.00 and this year we hoping to raise even more.

War Memorial Improvements

Contracts for the proposed work have now been issued and the work shall commence following the Village Fete. There will be some disruption in and around the war memorial and changing rooms during the period of work with trade vehicles entering the ground from Robert Street. This should not affect the start of the football season and spoil peoples general enjoyment of the ground.
